Students are required to complete approximately 8 hours of self-paced online pre-course work prior to the first day of class. The 10-week course of instruction will begin Monday January 26, 2026, with one week of classroom instruction followed by one week of facilitated distance learning. Students will have a two week break prior to the next two weeks of instruction. The course schedule is:

January 26 - 30, 2026 - Retreat
February 2 - 6, 2026 - Distance Learning
March 2 - 6, 2026 - Distance Learning
March 9 - 13, 2026 - Classroom Learning
April 6 - 10, 2026 - Distance Learning
April 13 - 17, 2026 - Classroom Learning
May 4 - 8, 2026 - Distance Learning
May 18 - 22, 2026 - Classroom Learning
June 1 - 5, 2026 - Distance Learning
June 8 - 12, 2026 - Classroom Learning

Tuition cost is \$4300. Completion of the Michigan State University First Line Supervision course prior to enrolling in the School of Staff and Command is encouraged.
